

A Just Harvest serves a hot lunch every day. FHC donates the meal served on the SECOND THURSDAY of each month. Please scan the OR Code to sign up for FOOD DONATIONS.

NON-PERISHABLES may be dropped in the AJH bin in the Bell Tower (open M-F, 7a-3p) any time BEFORE the WEDNESDAY preceding the SECOND THURSDAY of the month.

PERISHABLES MUST BE LEFT in the bin ON THAT WEDNESDAY BY 7:30am to ensure they're usable when delivered that morning to the AJH kitchen.

VOLUNTEERS are also needed to SERVE the FHC lunch on that SECOND THURSDAY of each month. Volunteers are asked to be at AJH from 11:15 to 2:30 to help with set-up, lunch, and clean-up. Lunch is served 12-2. Each server is asked to bring 2-3 gallons of whole or 2% milk. Please use the SignUp below to volunteer.

The next donation date is WEDNESDAY, June 12, for the lunch that will be served on THURSDAY, June 13.

AJH also runs a pantry, providing food to roughly 175 households every week. Donations of NON-PERISHABLES are always welcome and may be put in the Bell Tower bin. Suggested: canned chicken, tuna, fruit and vegetables; cereal, rice, pasta.

### FAITH HOPE and CARPENTERS puts CHARITY to work in our neighborhood

Thank you to all the volunteers and donors who made this year's two projects wonderful successes.

The first team of volunteers from Faith Hope and Loyola Academy assembled at a home in Northbrook to assist a disadvantaged homeowner reclaim an extremely overgrown yard. We removed enough overgrown evergreens, buckthorn and scrub trees to fill an entire 30 yard dumpster. We then re-planted many new shrubs and bushes and replaced a rotted wooden walkway with stone pavers. Some of our skilled parishioners added siding to a decaying carport added a new side yard fence for privacy. We added a cheerful touch by painting the front door of the house a welcoming bright red.

Our landscaping material was generously donated by parishioners Larry and Amy Thalmann, owners of Chalet Nursery. We also had assistance from a dozen Loyola Academy volunteers led by Lyle Baier and Adrianna Kelly of Campus Ministry.



Our homeowner commented:

"Having watched the work, dedication and kindness you all put into my home has been a blessing. There is a motivation that I feel after watching the hard work to keep my home looking and feeling good. Even if I had the money to pay for these services, it would never be this special" -Deborah

Our second talented and dedicated team helped organize and deep clean a condominium in Glencoe. We were also able to source several pieces of both gently-used and newly-assembled furniture that will make her living space much more usable. The team spent several days working with the owner to develop and execute a comprehensive plan to improve her home. As the owner is limited by a number of issues, our assistance allowed her to reset her home environment.










# **Eucharistic** Adoration
