

**Grade 3- Final Class**  
***The Apostles' Challenge***  
**Question Sheet**

Separate students into teams of 4 people each. To play, everyone lines up along the tape which marks the start. Several feet beyond the start is another taped line which designates the end. A leader will ask questions and give multiple-choice answers. The leader will ask each person to state which answer he/she believes is correct (so every participant answers every question). Each person that guesses correctly may take one step forward. Each person who guesses incorrectly must take one baby-step backwards. When all of your team members have reached the taped line at the end, your team wins!
