

Ten Commandments ★ Drill Four



- ❖ Have on your desk a set of the Ten Commandments Key Word Cards. Write "Team 1" and "Team 2" on the board behind you.
- ❖ Divide the class into two teams of equal ability. Instruct the teams to form two parallel lines facing you. The two people at the front of the lines will be "first up" together.
- ❖ Instruct the teams that you will say a key word that applies to one of the commandments. The first person to correctly name the commandment wins. (For example: if you say "vandalism," the response is "seventh.") The winner tallies a point for his or her team, then both players move to the end of the line. In case of a tie, give the pair another key word. Keep the activity moving quickly.
- ❖ Reverse the activity. You say a commandment number and ask the responder to give any key word that matches it. Don't allow "repeats" of key words.
