



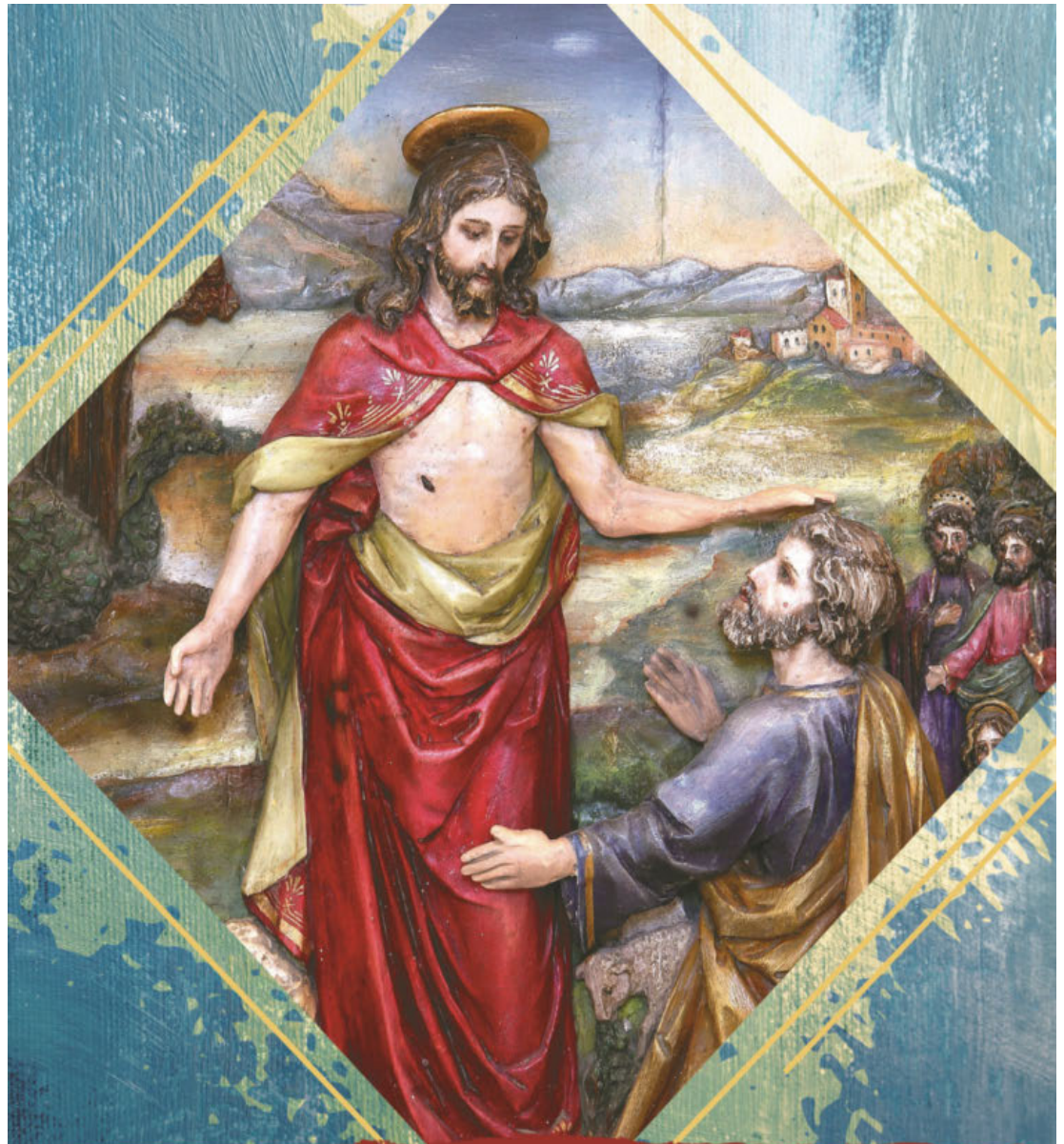

A Just Harvest serves a hot lunch every day. FHC donates the meal served on the **SECOND THURSDAY** of each month. Please scan the QR Code to sign up for **FOOD DONATIONS**.

NON-PERISHABLES may be dropped in the AJH bin in the Bell Tower (open M-F, 7a-3p) any time **BEFORE** the **WEDNESDAY** preceding the **SECOND THURSDAY** of the month.

PERISHABLES MUST BE LEFT in the bin **ON THAT WEDNESDAY** **BY 7:30am** to ensure they're usable when delivered that morning to the AJH kitchen.

VOLUNTEERS are also needed to **SERVE** the FHC lunch on that **SECOND THURSDAY** of each month. Volunteers are asked to be at AJH from 11:15 to 2:30 to help with set-up, lunch, and clean-up. Lunch is served 12-2. Each server is asked to bring 2-3 gallons of whole or 2% milk. Please use the SignUp below to volunteer.

The next donation date is **WEDNESDAY, May 7**, for the lunch that will be served on **THURSDAY, May 8**.

AJH also runs a pantry, providing food to roughly 175 households every week. Donations of **NON-PERISHABLES** are always welcome and may be put in the Bell Tower bin. Suggested: canned chicken, tuna, fruit and vegetables; cereal, rice, pasta.

Dear Parish Family of St. Faith, Hope, and Charity,

Greetings to all! My name is Fr. Brian Welter, and I would like to introduce myself as your new pastor beginning on July 1st. I am grateful to Fr. Marty for sharing with me about the parish and school, the great people of the community, and the many good things happening at Faith, Hope, and Charity. I am also grateful to Cardinal Cupich for the chance to be your pastor. I look forward to meeting you and learning about the parish, and I am honored to be part of the history of Faith, Hope, and Charity!



A little bit about me: I was born in Chicago and baptized at St. Margaret Mary Parish. Our family (mom, dad, and brother) moved early to the northwest suburb of Streamwood, where I attended public schools and graduated from Streamwood High in 1988. I then attended Bradley University in Peoria, where I studied Manufacturing Technology. After college, I worked in the construction field as a carpenter, framing and remodeling houses in the southwest suburbs.

During those years after college, I sensed a call to the priesthood as I re-engaged in my Catholic faith. I decided to enter Mundelein Seminary in the Fall of 2000 to study for priesthood. Cardinal Francis George ordained me a priest in May 2005 at Holy Name Cathedral in Chicago. My first assignment was at St. Elizabeth Seton parish in Orland Hills, IL. from 2005-2010. I served as Vocation Director for the Archdiocese of Chicago from 2010-2013, and I then became a faculty member at Mundelein Seminary from 2013-2020. The last five years, 2020-2025, I have been the Executive Director of the Institute for Priestly Formation in Omaha, Nebraska. The institute's mission is to help seminarians, priests, and bishops in their ongoing spiritual growth, so they are better prepared to lead others to Christ.

My Mom and Dad are retired and living in Colorado. My younger brother, his wife, and their son live in the northwest suburbs. Some of my enjoyable pastimes are being outdoors, spending time in Colorado hiking, reading, and visiting family. Also, for many years since ordination to priesthood, I have accompanied a group of dentists from several parishes in the Chicago area to a small village in Mexico where we set up a free dental clinic for a week each January or February.

I look forward to seeing you soon, hearing your stories, and growing in our life of faith. You are in my prayers until then.

Scripture Reflection Lead by Deacon Michael and Jean Cavanaugh on Zoom Wednesday Mornings

Our meetings dive into the readings for whatever Sunday is next. Here we address the many questions the readings raise in our minds, ones a homily cannot answer. We are welcome to express the confusion and skepticism that our thoughtful encounters with the readings may generate. What we learn from sharing these questions will prove illuminating, even surprising.

We utilize the critical/historical approach advanced by Fr. Donald Senior, CP, taught at the Chicago Theological Union and published in The Jerome Biblical Commentary for the 21st Century.

There is no charge for this, in contrast to its great value in expanding our faith. On Zoom, Wednesday mornings, 9 to 10 AM. (If this time does not work for you, what time is better?) It's a time you can share with a family member or friend anywhere in the world.

Days in advance, Jean Cavanaugh sends us a single-page preview of the readings, including the historical/cultural contexts from which they arise, and how they fit into the structure of our faith.

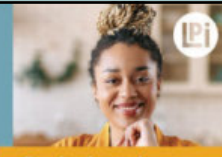
