A Just Harvest serves a hot lunch every day. FHC donates the meal served on the **SECOND THURSDAY** of each month. Please use the SignUp below to sign up for **FOOD DONATIONS**.

NON-PERISHABLES may be dropped in the **AJH bin in the back of church** (open daily 7a-12p) any time **BEFORE** the **WEDNESDAY** preceding the **SECOND THURSDAY** of the month. **PERISHABLES MUST BE LEFT in the bin ON THAT WEDNESDAY BY 7:30am** to ensure they're usable when delivered that morning to the AJH kitchen.

VOLUNTEERS are also needed to **SERVE** the FHC lunch on that **SECOND THURSDAY** of each month. Volunteers are asked to be at AJH from **11:15 to 2:30** to help with set-up, lunch, and clean-up. Lunch is served 12-2. Each server is asked to bring 2-3 gallons of whole or 2% milk. **Servers should wear closed-toe shoes and slacks or jeans (no shorts or skirts please)**. Please use the SignUp below to volunteer to serve.

The next donation date is **WEDNESDAY, June 10**, for the lunch that will be served on **THURSDAY, June 11**.

AJH also runs a pantry, providing food to roughly 175 households every week. Donations of **NON-PERISHABLES** are always welcome and may be put in the bin. Suggested: canned chicken, tuna, fruit and vegetables; cereal, rice, pasta.

We welcome Fr. Vincent Tuan Vu from the Diocese of Long Xuyen, Vietnam the weekend of June 13/14 to share his mission with us.

THE DIOCESE OF LONG XUYEN, VIETNAM

The Diocese of Long Xuyen serves the two provinces of An Giang and parts of two districts within the City of Can Tho. Located in the southwestern corner of Vietnam's Mekong Delta, the region borders Cambodia.

Today, the diocese serves more than 236,900 Catholics among a population of approximately 4.3 million people, representing about 5.6% of the population—below the national average. The diocese includes 198 parishes across roughly 6,500 square miles and is served by 365 priests (including 35 religious priests), 235 religious sisters, 95 religious brothers, 117 seminarians, 141 preparatory students, and 1,560 catechists.

In 1954, the Catholic population in the region was only about 30,000. Following the migration of Catholic refugees from North Vietnam, the number grew to 93,739 by 1964. Today, the diocese ministers to more than 236,000 faithful.

Vietnam continues to experience significant migration from rural areas to industrial cities and remote frontier regions. This presents a serious pastoral challenge, as many Catholic families relocate to areas without churches, catechetical programs, or parish communities.

To respond to these needs, the Diocese of Long Xuyen must build up to five chapels and numerous classrooms each year to serve these growing Catholic communities. We also continue training catechists and evangelization volunteers to support the mission of the New Evangelization.

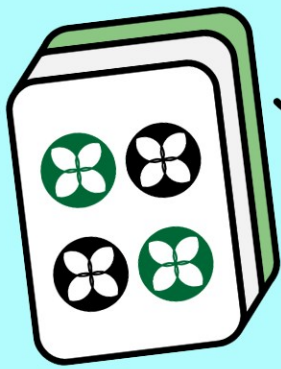

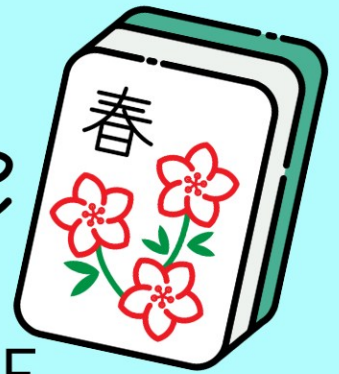

For centuries the Catholic Church has honored the Virgin Mary during the month of May with a variety of devotions, including a “May Crowning” in which a statue of Mary is crowned with a wreath of flowers. Honoring Mary during May began as early as the 13th century, when specific days in May were devoted to Mary. May is also associated with spring and new life, which Mary represents as the mother of Jesus, who gave the world new life through his death and resurrection.

Below are two traditional prayers to honor Mary: The Hail Mary (which is very familiar to us), and “The Memorare” (which some people are less familiar with). Let’s use the month of May to learn, by heart, prayers to the Virgin Mary.

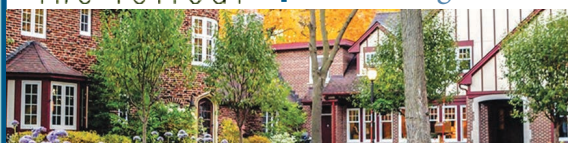
