

A Just Harvest serves a hot lunch every day. FHC donates the meal served on the **SECOND THURSDAY** of each month. Please scan the QR Code to sign up for **FOOD DONATIONS**.

NON-PERISHABLES may be dropped in the AJH bin in the Bell Tower (open M-F, 7a-3p) any time **BEFORE** the **WEDNESDAY** preceding the **SECOND THURSDAY** of the month.

PERISHABLES MUST BE LEFT in the bin **ON THAT WEDNESDAY** **BY 7:30am** to ensure they're usable when delivered that morning to the AJH kitchen.

VOLUNTEERS are also needed to **SERVE** the FHC lunch on that **SECOND THURSDAY** of each month. Volunteers are asked to be at AJH from **11:15 to 2:30** to help with set-up, lunch, and clean-up. Lunch is served **12-2**. Each server is asked to bring **2-3 gallons** of whole or 2% milk. Please use the SignUp below to volunteer.

The next donation date is **WEDNESDAY, July 9**, for the lunch that will be served on **THURSDAY, July 10**.

AJH also runs a pantry, providing food to roughly 175 households every week. Donations of **NON-PERISHABLES** are always welcome and may be put in the Bell Tower bin. Suggested: canned chicken, tuna, fruit and vegetables; cereal, rice, pasta.



HEARTS REUNITED

A small faith group of parishioners is partnering with the **Archdiocese of Chicago's Kolbe House Jail Ministry** to sponsor a "Hearts Reunited" bus trip on Saturday, August 9th for children to visit their dads in prison. Nearly 50% of individuals in prisons across Illinois have roots in the Chicago area, but the distance to prisons means visits from their loved ones are few and far between. By connecting dads with their children, we are supporting healthier development for children, strengthening family bonds, and increasing emotional wellness for dads in prison --- ultimately leading to more successful return to the community when they complete their sentences.

Help us reach our goal of \$3,500!

This money will pay for the bus for children and their caretakers to travel from Chicago plus food and activities for a fun-filled day of connection at Lincoln Correctional Center in Lincoln, IL. A few additional **volunteers are also needed** to help at the Correctional Center on August 9th. Let us know if you are interested!


