



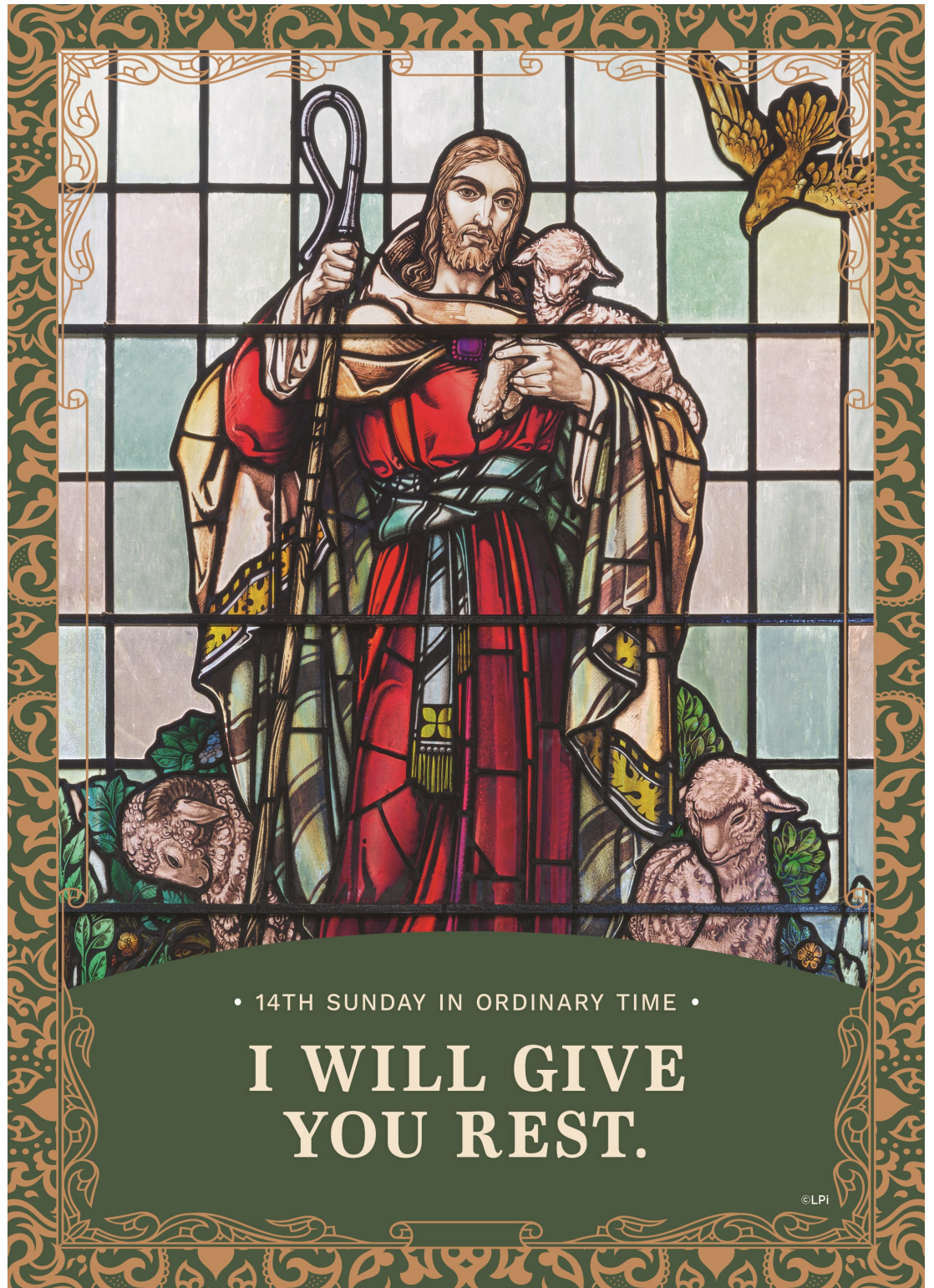

A Just Harvest serves a hot lunch every day. FHC donates the meal served on the **SECOND THURSDAY** of each month. Please use the SignUp below to sign up for **FOOD DONATIONS**.

NON-PERISHABLES may be dropped in the **AJH bin in the back of church** (open daily 7a-12p) any time **BEFORE** the **WEDNESDAY** preceding the **SECOND THURSDAY** of the month. **PERISHABLES MUST BE LEFT in the bin ON THAT WEDNESDAY BY 7:30am** to ensure they're usable when delivered that morning to the AJH kitchen.

**VOLUNTEERS** are also needed to **SERVE** the FHC lunch on that **SECOND THURSDAY** of each month. Volunteers are asked to be at AJH from **11:15 to 2:30** to help with set-up, lunch, and clean-up. Lunch is served 12-2. Each server is asked to bring 2-3 gallons of whole or 2% milk. **Servers should wear closed-toe shoes and slacks or jeans (no shorts or skirts please)**. Please use the SignUp below to volunteer to serve.

The next donation date is **WEDNESDAY, July 8**, for the lunch that will be served on **THURSDAY, July 9**.

AJH also runs a pantry, providing food to roughly 175 households every week. Donations of **NON-PERISHABLES** are always welcome and may be put in the bin. Suggested: canned chicken, tuna, fruit and vegetables; cereal, rice, pasta.

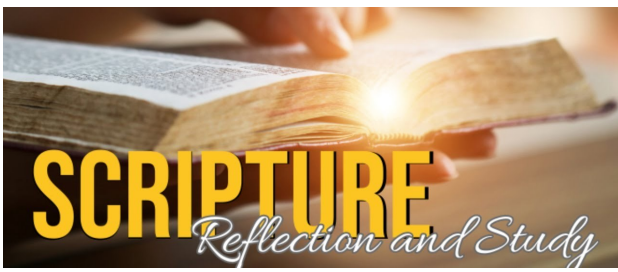


## CHILDREN'S LITURGY OF THE WORD

**Scripture Reflection Lead by Deacon Michael and Jean Cavanaugh on Zoom Wednesday Mornings**

We dive into the readings for whatever Sunday is next. We are welcome to express confusion or skepticism arising from thoughtful encounters with the readings. What we learn from sharing these questions is illuminating, even surprising.

We utilize the critical/historical approach advanced by Fr. Donald Senior, CP, taught at the Chicago Theological Union and published in The Jerome Biblical Commentary for the 21st Century.

**School Boiler Replacement Project – This Summer**

We are pleased to share that this summer we will be replacing all three boilers that heat the school and pre-school – a significant and necessary investment in our facilities.



Of our three existing units, one has been out of service for more than a year, and the remaining two have exceeded their lifespan. Replacing all three at once allows us to restore full heating capacity to the school while avoiding the higher costs of staggered replacements down the road.

Work is expected to take place over the summer months, and we anticipate minimal disruption to normal parish activities. However, please be aware that a small number of parking spaces near the gym may be temporarily unavailable during portions of the project. We appreciate your patience and flexibility.

More details will be shared as the project gets underway.

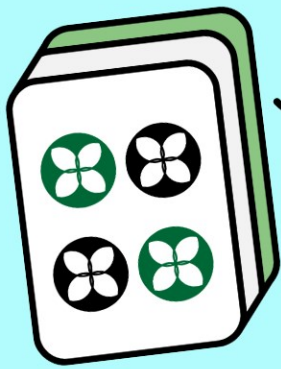

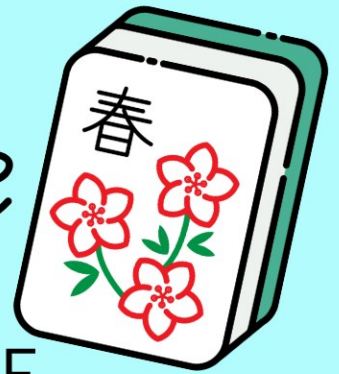

## GOSPEL MEDITATION

This weekend, our nation celebrates the 250<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the signing of the Declaration of Independence. Unlike most nations, the United States was not founded primarily on a shared ethnicity, language, or culture. Instead, our founders built a political community out of diverse peoples united by a shared vision of liberty. That vision echoes something deep in the Christian mystery revealed in today's Gospel.

Jesus returns to his hometown. The people see only what is familiar: the carpenter, the son of Mary, one of their own. As Mark tells us, **"They took offense at him. Jesus said, 'A prophet is not without honor except in his native place and among his own kin and in his own house.'"** Their narrow vision blinds them. Jesus has come to inaugurate a new communion that transcends geography, bloodlines, and culture. He has come to unite all people in himself.

At its best, America's national unity reflects this possibility, which fully subsists only in the Catholic Church. Our unity is not based on ancestry or tribe, but on a shared commitment to higher ideals. For this reason, we can love our country with gratitude while situating patriotism within the broader horizon of faith.

Rooted in Christ, we are less vulnerable to the unholy tribalism that threatens civic life and faith. This weekend, let us thank God for our nation and pray that we also live as citizens of Heaven in Jesus Christ.
