

A Just Harvest serves a hot lunch every day. FHC donates the meal served on the SECOND THURSDAY of each month. Please scan the QR Code to sign up for FOOD DONATIONS.

NON-PERISHABLES may be dropped in the AJH bin in the Bell Tower (open M-F, 7a-3p) any time BEFORE the WEDNESDAY preceding the SECOND THURSDAY of the month.

PERISHABLES MUST BE LEFT in the bin ON THAT WEDNESDAY BY 7:30am to ensure they're usable when delivered that morning to the AJH kitchen.

VOLUNTEERS are also needed to SERVE the FHC lunch on that SECOND THURSDAY of each month. Volunteers are asked to be at AJH from 11:15 to 2:30 to help with set-up, lunch, and cleanup. Lunch is served 12-2. Each server is asked to bring 2-3 gallons of whole or 2% milk. Please use the SignUp below to volunteer.

The next donation date is WEDNESDAY, August 13, for the lunch that will be served on THURSDAY, August 14.

AJH also runs a pantry, providing food to roughly 175 households every week. Donations of NON-PERISHABLES are always welcome and may be put in the Bell Tower bin. Suggested: canned chicken, tuna, fruit and vegetables; cereal, rice, pasta.

FHC 2025 Mission Appeal for Aguleri Diocese, Nigeria. Faith Hope welcomes Rev. Francis Igboanugo the weekend of August 2/3

The Catholic Diocese of Aguleri, located in southeastern Nigeria, covers an area of 536 square miles which encompasses 26 communities with a population of over 1.8 million people of whom approximately 357,000 are Catholics.

The Catholic Diocese of Aguleri recognizes an urgent need to educate young girls. Our Diocese is deeply committed to addressing it directly. We are working hard to build Catholic boarding schools to protect and educate these girls while preparing them for a better future. However, building schools and hiring teachers is a costly undertaking. The cost to keep a girl in school for a year including basic needs is approximately \$500. To support around 600 girls from the peripheries of our Diocese we need about \$300,000. While we are doing our best to provide as much assistance as we can, we are counting on your help. Your support will enhance the quality of life in our society and strengthen the work of evangelization in the Aguleri Diocese.

We thank you for your support. Please know that we are praying for the Archdiocese of Chicago and especially for the Parishioners of Ss. Faith, Hope & Charity.

A small faith group of parishioners is partnering with the Archdiocese of Chicago's Kolbe House Jail Ministry to sponsor a "Hearts Reunited" bus trip on Saturday, August 9th for children to visit their dads in prison. Nearly 50% of individuals in prisons across Illinois have roots in the Chicago area, but the distance to prisons means visits from their loved ones are few and far between. By connecting dads with their children, we are supporting healthier development for children, strengthening family bonds, and increasing emotional wellness for dads in prison --- ultimately leading to more successful return to the community when they complete their sentences.

This money will pay for the bus for children and their caretakers to travel from Chicago plus food and activities for a fun-filled day of connection at Lincoln Correctional Center in Lincoln, IL. 


