



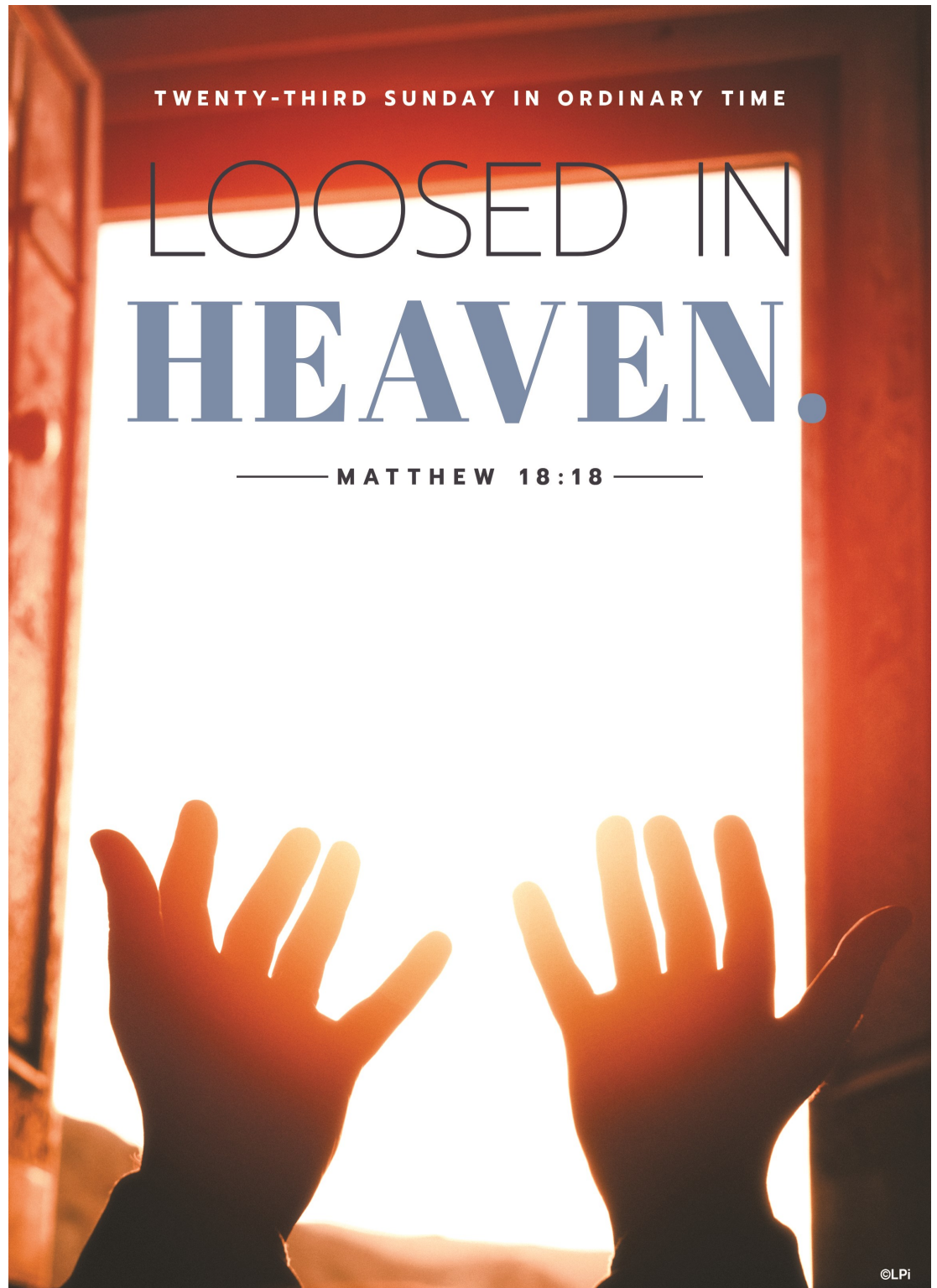

Lunch is served 12-2. Each server is asked to bring 2-3 gallons of whole or 2% milk. **Servers should wear closed-toe shoes and slacks or jeans (no shorts or skirts please)**. Faithful Stewardship of Your Gifts

A financial stewardship update from your parish leadership

Your financial generosity is at the heart of everything we do at Ss. Faith, Hope and Charity, and we want you to know that contributions supporting our community are being cared for well. Over the past year — from September 2025 to May 2026 — we partnered with the Parish Operations Support – Accounting Services Center at the Archdiocese of Chicago to conduct a Financial and Human Resources Best Practices Review that aligned with the arrival of our new pastor, Fr. Brian Welter.

We are able to report the review did not identify any evidence of fraudulent activity, though the Parish’s financial recordkeeping fell short of expected standards. The issues identified were the result of inconsistent or incomplete accounting practices and insufficient oversight rather than intentional misconduct. Your gifts, offerings, and contributions were used for their intended purpose to support the life, ministry, and mission of our Parish.

As a result of this review, we have made meaningful improvements across several financial areas — including collections, bookkeeping, vendor records and bank accounts, to name a few. We are pleased to announce the formation of a new Parish Finance Council with representatives from the Church, School, and Religious Education. We have also hired Vanessa Baldwin, who previously worked at the Archdiocese of Chicago for nearly 12 years, as Operations Director, and put stronger safeguards in place so your contributions to the Parish and School are properly accounted for. We are also now keeping separate books for the Church and School, which are closed monthly.

Our budget was submitted to the Archdiocese of Chicago and approved on time, and we are on target to share a full annual financial report for the year ended June 30, 2026 with the community in October.

Thank you for your trust — it is a responsibility we do not take lightly, and we remain committed to being faithful stewards of your generosity.

For those interested, the OCIA (the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults, *formerly RCIA*) is beginning this Fall. OCIA is designed for those who are considering joining the Catholic Church through celebrating the sacraments of initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist) at the Easter Vigil. The process welcomes adults who have never been baptized, those who have been baptized in another Christian tradition, or baptized Catholics who have not received Eucharist or Confirmation.

The OCIA process gathers adults to talk about faith in the light of our Roman Catholic tradition. The goal is to welcome people to our Church community at Easter time. We will meet on a weekly basis beginning Tuesday, September 15 at 7pm, with time off around Christmas. The traditional time to welcome new members to the Church is at Easter. 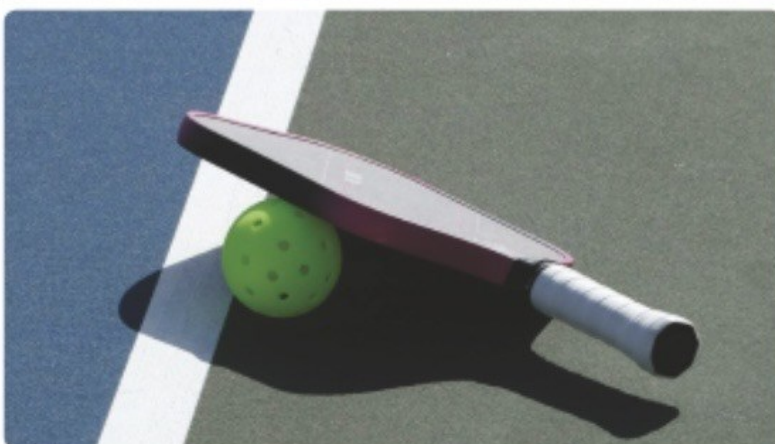

Whatever we were to each other, that we are still

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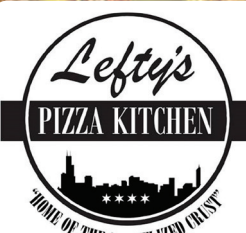
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
